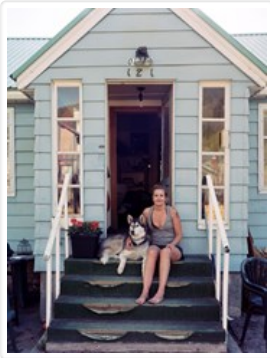

Date:	1920 – 1940
Material:	skin
Dimensions:	40.0 x 128.0 cm
Description:	<p>A tanned flat open black river otter pelt with short thick glossy dark brown, almost black, fur becoming silvery along the edges (belly and throat). There is a long tail thick at the base and the left rear paw remains attached. There are many small holes in the head (eyes, ears, etc). A tag attached is marked "XLU-PB \$100.00 Black otter - very rare." The head is marked, with pencil, "LU.PB" and the body has "Bliss & Cohn Ltd. -- nnipeg Man." stamped inside a diamond shape with "WM"? perforated in the tail.</p>

Title:	Lutra Canadensis Pelts
Date:	1930 – 1960
Material:	skin
Dimensions:	50.0 (a); 44.0 (b) x 173.0 (a); 159.0 (b) cm
Description:	Two tanned, flat open river otter pelts: a) A short thick glossy brown fur becoming very light and silvery on the sides of the head (throat) with a long dark tail with a thick base. There are several small holes in the head (eyes, ears, etc). The fur is marked with "UU.NN \$65.00" on the head, "A.H. &S. Ltd - Montreal - Can" stamped inside an oval on the body, and with "UN," "WM" and "32" perforated at the tail.b) A short thick glossy brown fur becoming silvery at the edges (belly and throat) with a long thick tail. There are many small holes in the head (eyes, ears, etc). The fur is marked "EIBN -66" on the head with "EB" and other illegible initials perforated at the tail.

Description:	The stone color used here is green with black specks. The otter stands on all four of his short legs with his head up and tail outstretched. The face features and front toes are carved in great detail and inlaid with a white substance. The body of the otter is long, slender and finished with a smooth surface.
