Title:	Pipe

Description:	A wooden pipe bowl shaped like a curved horn with silver around the rim of the bowl and more silver where the stem would join. The bowl is marked on the silver rim with "AFAC" and hallmarks, and also on the silver stem joint with hallmarks and "R" inside a diamond shape.

Title:	Pipe

Description:	A simple clay pipe, bowl and stem. Bowl is more or less an elongated teardrop, steam is straight, has a small "blip" below the bowl. White clay, stained with use. "T" and "D" on back of wall of bowl, "C78 W. White" and "Scotland" on stem.

Material:	metal; wood
Dimensions:	1.6 x 1.0 x 16.5 cm
Description:	Three tobacco pipes (kiseru) which consist of tiny brass bowls with elongated extensions which connect to bamboo stems which connect to brass mouthpieces which are extruded and come to a small bore. (a) has Japanese calligraphic ideogram under bowl and mouthpiece, no other decoration. (b) has decorations that look like an old man of the sea, and (c) has floral decorations on bowl and mouthpiece.
