Title: Change Purse

Description: Contained in wooden box (a), rectangular, bright vermilion red purse with

silk embroidered flap depicting blue bridge passing over gold stream embroidered on back. Front full pocket expands by folded gussets at the sides, is lined with aqua fabric, and covered with full flap which fastens by means of red and gold enamelled ivory clip which hooks around thread loop on front of purse. Back compartment is laced with red thread at the sides to expand, and holds a pad of folded paper squares which is held together by two paper "staples", and fits the compartment very tightly. (b) wooden box, plain, rectangular, lightweight. Box lid fits over small lip on bottom. Red, round paper label at middle top of box with East-Asian writing, product label ? stamped on one side with round, purple stamp

mark.

Description: A round metal button badge containing a sepia-coloured photograph on a

white background, of King George VI and Queen Elizabeth, covered with plastic. There is a small, gold-covered royal crown on the top and a royal blue ribbon hanging from below the badge. The gold lettering on the front of the ribbon reads "A Royal Welcome from BANFF". The metal crown and the ribbon are inserted under the button top and safety back, secured by the piece of metal turned under the rim becoming the vertical straight pin to attach the badge onto fabric. On the inside back there is a circular piece of paper with blue background and white lettering: "TAG-DAY7 SOCIETY GOODS. BADGE 7 SPECIALITY CO. LIMITED. P.O. BOX

456 MONTREAL"

handle stamped EPNS. Spoon fits into notch in mustard pot lid. Mustard

pot is cylindrical, flat-based with blue glass cylindrical removable

container. Mustard pot handle has hinged lid and has diagonal open-slate design plus a fixed crest, "SS Sailing Ship, Duchess of Bedford". Base of mustard pot stamped "EPNS Made in England".(c-d) Salt and pepper similar frame design as mustard pot and contain blue glass cylindrical containers, dome flush fitted tops, same affixed crest, both stamped

"EPNS" on base, note corrosion on pepper container.
