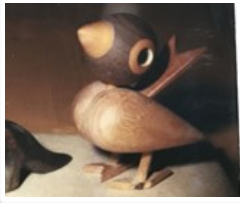

Description:	A model of a black bear in a small wooden crate "Here's a Bear I caught just for You" is inscribed in black on the top of the brown wooden crate. Banff Canada on the front wood cross piece. Inside the crate is a plastic model of a black bear with red snout. On the bottom is a red and white address sticker for mailing the souvenir "From" and "To" with red lines for an address. 1.50 sticker price is still on the top.

Title:	Bird Figurine
Date:	1960 – 1963
Material:	wood; rubber
Dimensions:	8.5 x 5.0 x 6.5 cm
Description:	Mass produced stylized bird constructed of various natural coloured spheres of wood, joined with dowels. Head has black rubber inset eyes and head swivels 360 degrees. Chip on left foot. Feet form base.

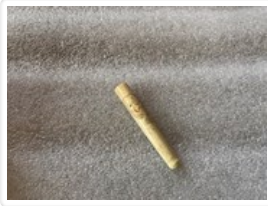

Title:	Bird Figurine

Material:	wood
Dimensions:	8.0 x 3.6 x 11.5 cm
Description:	Simple duck like bird which has been scorched and sand blasted to reveal grain marks in wood. Stamped "Gerd Canada" on bottom. Grain of wood defines eyes and wing of bird.

Title:	Cigarette Holder
Date:	1920 – 1940
Material:	ivory
Dimensions:	0.6 x 1.1 x 7.7 cm
Description:	A medium length cigarette holder carved of ivory with drawing of elephant incised on it. Round at end to hold cigarette, tapering slightly and flattening at mouthpiece which has carved ferrule to grip with teeth, small hole drilled through. Incised drawing of elephant around side with eye painted black and mouth painted red. Slight nicotine stains at round end.

Description:	A decorative dish made from a hand-coloured photograph. 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Lapel Pin

Title:	Lapel Pin
Date:	1917 – 1930
Material:	metal
Dimensions:	2.7 x 1.0 cm
Description:	A silver, plated over copper, round lapel pin of U.S. Glacier National Park which snaps to another, similarly shaped backing. Separate seal soldered to front depicts mountain goat standing in relief at centre, with band around reading, Glacier National Park See America First". Pin button stands on post flattening to another smaller button at back with snap socket, backing button is the same, without the seal applied, and containing the snap post fitting the socket of the front.

Description: Smooth, rounded netsuke carved from medium brown hardwood. Snail emerging from rounded shell. One large and one small cord hole in bottom of netsuke, ideogram carved on underside. Snail's skin pitted to create contours.

Title: Netsuke

Date: 1800 – 1890



Material:	wood
Dimensions:	3.0 x 3.2 x 3.9 cm
Description:	Smooth, rounded netsuke carved from medium brown hardwood. Snail emerging from rounded, coiled shell. Cord passage hole created by gap between snail foot and shell. Carved signature within rectangle near base of netsuke. Large crack in netsuke and one of large snail antennae is broken off in a large section and is missing. Crack possibly caused by humidity changes or damage.

Title:	Netsuke
Date:	1800 – 1890
Material:	ivory; glass ?
Dimensions:	4.5 x 2.0 x 3.5 cm
Description:	Two monkeys, larger, female, holding double gourd and smaller monkey perched on larger monkey's shoulders and head. Gourd being clutched by front left arm and rear right leg, large monkey's right arm scratching right hip. Left eye, both monkeys have detailed glass inset eyes, of baby monkey missing. Fine tooling has created hair lines overall surface. Cord hole between legs of seated monkey. Signature on bottom, within oval .
