Description: In the top section of the poster design there is a cartoon drawing of a man in a suit jacket, vest, and tie flying through the air on skis. He has no poles in his hands suggesting that he could be ski jumping. Below the man there is three distinct mountains, with clouds behind them, and trees framing the the edges of the drawing. Below the drawing it says "WITH APOLOGIES TO DEBECK", "Peter White - 1924", and "Banff WINTER CARNIVAL - FEBRUARY 7-14. 1925 - The Peoples Playground SKI-ING SWIMMING SKATING TOBOGGANING, ETC." Surrounding the inscription it is bordered with 3mm design: two lines running parallel to each other with circles drawn in the middle.

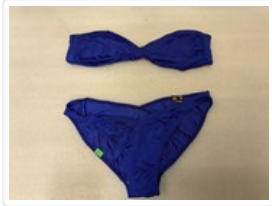

Title:	Bathing Suit

Material:	fibre; nylon; licra
Dimensions:	13.3 x 36.4 cm
Description:	A two-piece shiny royal blue bathing suit. a) The top piece of the bathing suit is strapless, with a twist in between the two cups and ruching along the edge of the cups. The back is clasped with a plastic hook. A tag on the inner right side reads "L" in black text. b) The bottom piece of the bathing suit appear high cut, with a slight v in the front and back. On the left side of the v in the front and is a diagonal line (appears to be a stitch of new fabric - same colour). On the left side on the back side is the same thing. There is a neon green sticker with "5.0" handwritten. The tag reads "IPANEMA L" below a design of palm trees and sunset. Behind that tag reads "80% NYLON 20% LICRA NO EXPRIMIR". There is a shiny gold-ish netting in the crotch of the bathing suit. 21.7 x 36.3 cm.

Dimensions:	46.0 x 30.8 cm
Description:	Multiple sketches throughout paper: 1) Boxed off drawing of a mountain, with clouds above it and trees framing the edges, 2) A cabin surrounded by snow, with smoke coming out of the chimney, and there are some trees on either side of the cabin, 3) A lighthouse/fort like structure on the edge of a rocky cliff that has ocean waves beating up against the rocks, 4) A small cabin at the bottom of a mountain surrounded by snow, there are trees in the background and smoke coming out of the chimney, 5) In an almond shaped outline there is a profile cartoon sketch of a man with a large nose, wearing glasses, and he has a mustache, 6) A sketch of three trees, 7) Profile cartoon sketch of a man in a dress shirt and tie that is wearing a hat, 8) A mountain that is framed by trees and has a single cloud up above the peak, 9) Full body sketch of a man in profile cartoon style, and he is wearing a suit, 10) Cartoon sketch of a man's head in profile, he appears to be wearing a scarf, 11) A cactus in the middle of a desert, 12) A sketch of a field that has trees off in the background, and is lined with a fence made from rope and two linear objects put together in an 'x' shape. 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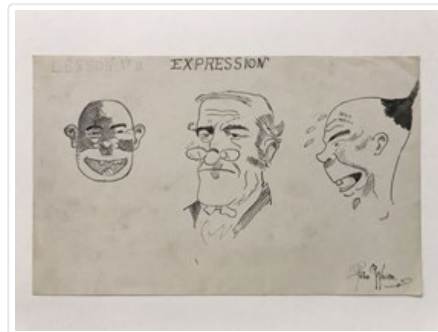

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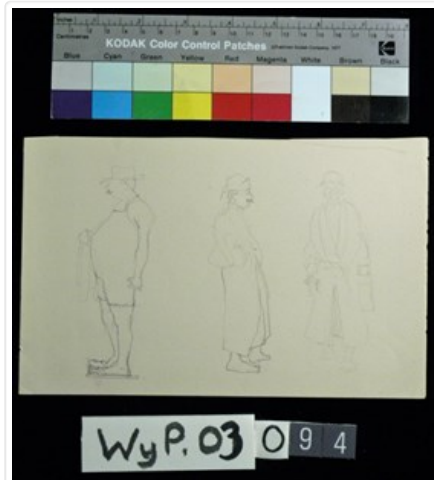

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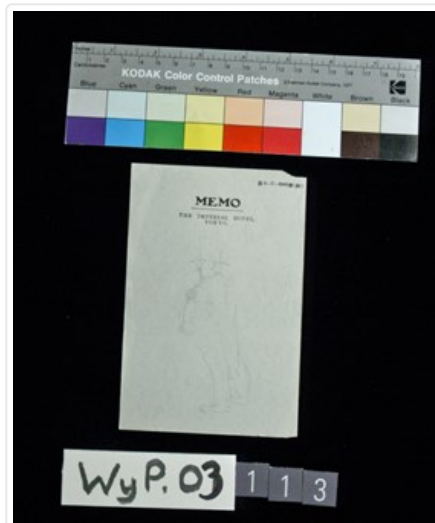
