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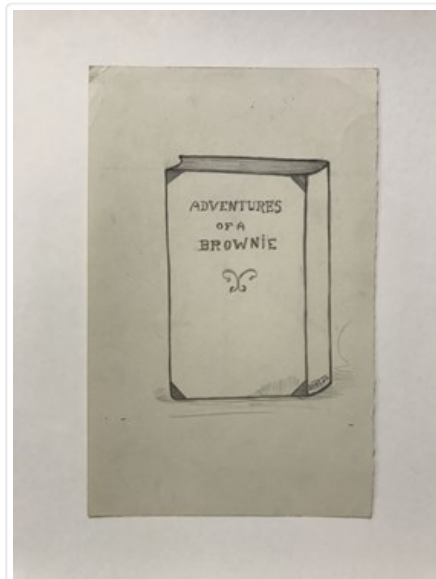

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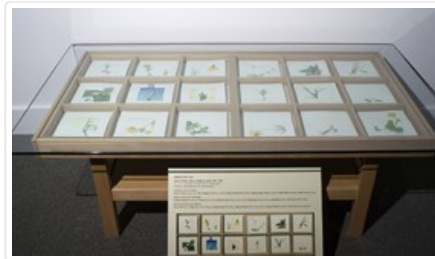

The lighter is empty, but does still spark when struck - handle with care. |

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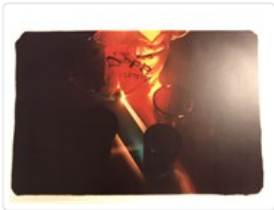
