There is a round, intricate, gold-coloured design <br> (7.0cm radius) in the centre of the face. There are two black clock hands, <br>  <br> hour and minute, and two smaller mini faces (both measuring 2.0cm <br> wide) above and below the centre of the face. The top mini face is an <br> alarm, with numbers 1-12. The bottom mini face displays the seconds, in <br>  <br> degrees of 10 with numbers. On top of the bell there is a gold-coloured <br> ring, possibly used for carrying. There are two gold-coloured splayed legs <br> to support the clock when upright. | Description: | Ornate mantle clock made by Seth Thomas Clock Co. The clock has a <br> body of black lacquered wood, with ornately carved gold-coloured feet, <br> four ionic-style columns at the front, sections of red, grey, and black <br> stone, and carved golden lion heads with rods in their mouths on each <br> end. The front wooden panel is carved with a curlicue design around the <br> clock-face. The face has a gold frame, scalloped inner frame, black <br> numbering, and two black hands. There are two holes to wind the clock at <br> the "4" and " 8 " and a smaller hole near the middle with arrows pointing <br> clockwise and counter clockwise with the letters "F" and "S" respectively. <br> "SETH THOMAS" is printed near the centre of the face and <br> "MANUFACTURED IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA" is printed <br>  <br> at the bottom of the face.
