Parade through Banff avenue at 10.00 a.m. to 10.30 a.m. where judging for the following will take place:

Also suitable prizes for others will be given according to the discretion of the judges.

From Banff avenue the parade will proceed to the Banff Springs Hotel via Hotel Bretton Hall grounds. At the Banff Springs Hotel the prizes for the above will be presented and officials of the C.P.R. will meet the Stony Chiefs. The parade will return to the village and disperse.

At two o'clock, at the Banff race track, the program as printed will be carried out.

Accommodation tickets may be had at any of the hotels. These tickets are good for travel in any autos carrying the Indian Day committee's sanction and will take you TO, INTO and BACK from the grounds.
