the winter season.**

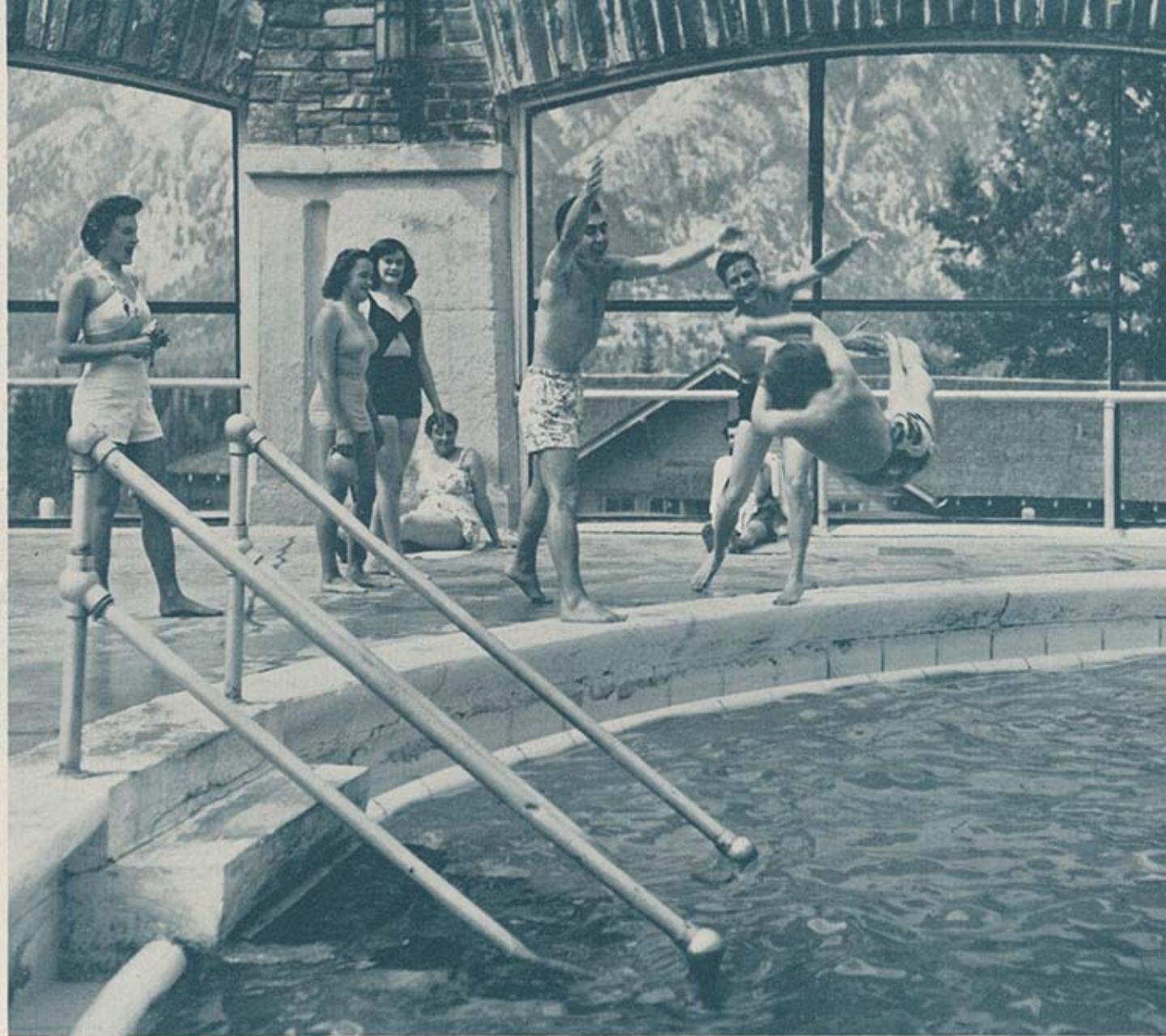
