& had visit in my noon - all

first water ouzel - also one f.  
harlequin - someone saw one  
w. 9 babies - another counted  
11. Rain a good deal of time  
& sun out briefly - we can leg  
past grassy lakeside trail - over  
from w. high water, by taking  
trail through woods w. covered  
by bridge. Bath, rest, dinner w Anne  
Fielding (she doesn't partake) & Mrs.  
Nicole <sup>as before</sup> & husband later. Lamb for  
dinner very nice but vegetables are  
not cooked enough - Did laundry  
& to bed early - but didn't sleep till  
1:30 AM. Tues. Pessler played some

~~July 16~~ Wed July 16 Mist & rain - Barometer still down to 48° - chilly & heat on. Huffy omelets for breakfast. One of Army family took pictures. Nessler left on bus much kissing & horn blown for both morning buses - long bird line - Came up & wrote diary. Looked for articles on wolverines few oujels, sandpipers, golden-necked - rock rabbits, porcupine skeleton on lake trail - are the wolverines responsible? The Animal Encyclopedia has Table of contents in 1st vol only. Has pictures & only general characteristics of wolverines - we five went down upper left trail of Cedarait Brook, crossed at the two bridges & came up rocky side, then around lake - all in for lunch - Intermittent rain, sun trying to come thru once in a while - slept in aft

skipped tea - Drinks on balcony  
w. Anne Fielding, Alberga Link -  
To bed early & slept better.

Thurs. July 17. Barometer lowest  
it has been - Link says 29. Temp  
46°. Early bus people have no  
where to go so ordered breakfast  
lobbig full - Kids playing games  
on floor - wrote diary. Went out  
with girls down left side of Cate-  
raut Brook - upright sides  
& around lake. In for lunch.  
Read twice, rest, back etc - Drinks  
on balcony w/ Anne Fielding  
& others when Polly arrived  
saying they expected her at  
their cabin 7/10 - went down  
Rev Brodie & Mary Phelps there  
w. my crowd - Read & talked.  
after dinner - Sue Davies plus  
will be here tomorrow w/ b  
fried about 12 noon for lunch.  
To bed about 9:30 & slept  
better - out desserts.

Claire Story

Fri July 18 Misty still but  
got outter up 80 degree -  
Sue + <sup>Claire</sup> arrived on 8 AM  
bus - had heavy pants + heavy  
stout boots - Left dry pants  
in my room & off to opabin  
Lake - Polly, How, Aglards  
+ I to Catudair + Creek Bend  
+ to Mary Lake - Polly Cr. at  
late & I didn't watch + we  
got on trail out to point. We  
came back to bridge + they  
started again - I left them  
brushwhacked down to  
Sid graves horse trail + followed  
it to Crystal cave trail - Up  
that some distance but it  
was too far to timber line  
to lodges + changed boots + blouse  
Sue + <sup>Mary</sup> Claire came in about  
11:50 having gone to opabin lake.  
Polly + I at one table with them  
other girls next table - Pitts  
came on 11 am bus - Baetzen

too - Clam Chowder & shrimp  
Sandwich lunch wh. they greatly  
enjoyed - Then they went to Mac  
Arthur Lake in about 1 3/4 - Tea  
on Polly & as bus was full, went  
down in station wagon driven  
by Harry (crown prince of O'Hara!)  
Had rest, bath, diary, read Time  
To Cabin 10 w. Polly, Flora & Eileen for  
dinner - Took Seagranus V.O wh. was  
nearly done - I finished Scotch before.  
Good salmon for dinner - Walked  
down along lake to cabin 2 + 10 but  
chilly - Ford was to show Pipe  
line Teaskan film at 9:30 was  
of wild life & studies of effect of Pipe  
line on cariboo, birds & other animals  
oil Co had spent millions on it. Film  
was noisy - oil is refrigerated  
has simulator every 50 miles  
Pipe to be underground - Ford going  
to Lytton with Currie Aug 4 or  
at least by his invitation wrote  
diary & to bed at 11 PM.

Sat July 19. Trip to MacA Lake,  
not clear of ice - Eileen does  
not go - has to look after her  
dog - I was behind - nothing  
on Schaffer Lake - Took trail  
up to cabin through great  
meadow. Ptarmigan & young  
seen - Seemed at lake - whereat  
my new Norica camera re-  
wind lever fell apart into  
five pieces - had hard time  
to find fifth piece - Polly did  
I was disgusted; Back leg horse  
trail - A flowered violets - Tried  
to put camera together but  
thought there must be another  
piece (There apparently wasn't)  
Ford had cocktail party - our  
whole group - the albergs, Mrs.  
Cochran (the Wilcoxes), + the  
Locklans (?) he a doctor. Talked  
to him a lot about Rockies +  
park policies trails etc.  
good buffet as usual +

staff show fire - two new studs  
very about a bug in a mattole  
body & another story told by  
one girl these words garbled by  
the other - will get it ards -

Sun. July 20. Trip to Oesa Lake  
Polly & Muriel to Uivavay Col  
but A & I back by regular way  
Flora wasn't feeling too good  
& stayed home - All at lake by  
big rock w. creatures eating  
tidbits & one marmot ate most  
of a rapping I had wrapped hard  
boiled egg in (a penguin at the  
buffet) Told to woman  
whose husband & family had  
gone up slope to see hurt at  
Abbott Pass - Aileen A. fell on  
way down but wasn't hurt.  
I got a scare as steep pitch  
was very near. In room when  
knock on door came & there  
was Rhoda Rouse. - She was

with photo group fr. Calgary.  
Had tea w. her & then girls  
came in too. I excused my-  
self to wash & dress, then  
came down as girls went  
to do same. Rivalda was  
on special bus to leave at  
first - lots of people in Lodge  
& both buses loaded. To  
cocktail party at Rev. Broche  
Cabins at 5:40 a bit late. Had  
20 there at least. Elaborate  
hor d'oeuvres - sausages, anti-  
choles, crackers & cheese - toast  
with various decorations, olives

forego dessert. Parked in  
sun. Tired but slept well.  
mon July 21. Left on 9 am bus.  
Car started OK - Stop at Chateau  
Reservations house & left there

to take us further up trail - Don &  
I went to Homestead for dinner  
had asparagus on toast w. garnish  
very good but too much. - Went to  
her place & I put on my one reel  
of pictures which look good - I could  
not tell if they were all in focus  
w. only my smallest viewer -

Tues July 22 Have room 103 at  
Red Carpet w. car right at door.  
Found water had gotten in & soaked  
fishing rod cases, duffles etc - it  
seemed to be under rubber mat.  
Took every thing out to dry & went  
to Standard Service but Bruce

couldn't tell where water got in  
went to Homestead & had Denver  
sandwich which is egg omelet  
bet toast - pretty good - no onion  
or cheese - I wondered if they  
were all the same as I was late.  
& waitress was "dixing her orange  
juice" waited long enough &  
Brooklyn girl went for her - got  
fondue & sl. bag duffles from  
Dorothy - The horse is being  
painted by a neighbor - Tillie  
had hers done so Muriel thought  
she should too - also got several  
things from suitcases in Dorothy's  
bedroom - Left suitcase keys  
believed so bad to make two  
trips - In a dither packing for  
three trips - Repacked both  
bags & listed articles in every  
thing - Too much food everywhere  
so went back to package place  
up on Mt. & Spray Ave - in same

spot as Saal. Lerry's spot was in  
War II when we were in Browne  
House - Dor. said they were allowed  
to build restaurant there because  
it was a reconstruction, not a new  
bldg - I had vegetable soup &  
pastas - the first was especially  
for me. Returned to room & read  
Time wh I had gotten in Banff.  
wed July 23 yesterday I slept till  
9 am - Today awoke at 7 am - up  
about 7:30 & went to Adrienne  
Restaurant for usual breakfast.  
"Libera" at B.C. is off on Wed &  
yesterday she had too many  
people to serve us & I had read  
on counter side - girl OR but not  
to write home about "went to Dor. H  
to get alarm clock out of my  
old suitcase" like three painting  
windows - Said Dor. was at church  
for Communion - had gone with  
Mrs. [unclear]  
who lives across road

walked towards church & Alice H. appeared coming up road  
walked down riding so wrot  
her - had too much to do to  
phone Polly at O'Hara as she  
had intended. - She runs the  
Waterton Lake trip & had a lots  
to do too - went through Peers  
Rest walk away to Mt Royal  
Parking lot & Trail Riders  
Hikers office there - Found  
Charles & Olive Everest there  
to register Hikers & take baggage  
etc. Few people I know on trail  
Dor. Hawkes said I would  
room w. Olive & Ellen Lindholm at  
at camp - Long talk - then went  
& got camera & took picture  
of new building Davies house  
went back to Dor. H & she had  
returned about 11 am just  
after I had left - (also had  
taken my two bags back to

Everest) She got ready & went  
to Johnson's Canyon to see if  
Swift was on nest (it wasn't &  
no young either) had barbecue  
& wild shake - Dor. same w.  
tea, 35¢ she thinks is too much  
hey treat - went up fire road  
but & sunny - went too far up  
but falls three are nice - back  
to first trail down - & a long  
way down too - came out on  
viewpoint but trails are cleared  
Party of girls too near falls for  
comfort. Told them they were  
foolish to go so near edge &  
that people fall in every year.  
See, small children also  
running loose too & I told them!  
On return parents had hold of them  
Left Dor at her house - will park  
my car there tomorrow - Long rest  
To Pausa for soup - chicken noodle  
not as good as vegetable - ate  
banana in room afterwards

her. I was here to check cooling system - Told him I was Ruth Brewster's friend & he asked for her. Also told him he was so kind to her, I thought I would come here! His family was waiting for him so he was in a hurry - Went to Hikers get together - late for trees by now I didn't know as I couldn't find spot to park my car - knew few there - Howard Harlie showed films - all flowers so I left at 8:30. Wrote diary  
Thurs July 24. Diced sleep while & feet miserable nose running & feet I was getting some things. Determined I would go to Boston & come back if not better - Read Brewster at Dix Depot slaudugly gate or fence to Mt. Royal & chatted with him about trip in & out by going by house Party left

I went to Bud's house - Annette  
there & her brother Bud ate break-  
fast standing up & had lots to ar-  
range with Annette who was  
in but will go again on Sunday.  
I went ice skating like this  
They have a horse on the fire  
place mantel of horse man with  
sev. parts done by Mac? Bud  
had friend George Iverson  
~~who~~ ~~now~~ works on turbines  
who will go with him - we  
finally got off up Spray - Bud  
having Key - Corral about  $\frac{1}{2}$   
mile from parking place, for  
water into Assin - I walked  
up to it - two trails there, one  
fenced off - while men were  
parking the horses (13) Barbara &  
Walt Sparling drove up with  
Chenoweth & other man, two cars  
much talk & pictures - Finally  
off after eating meat sandwich  
for lunch. We had beer +

other drifts - Stream this  
through willow bushes. - I had  
Bill Bagley's pet horse - had  
slower walk than Buds  
& then foxtrot - name Ralph.  
Left about 1:50. In camp  
about 5 PM or before. Stopped  
20 mi at Rogers cabin - His  
name Joe & he had little son  
with him - Had been advised  
how both father & son were  
asleep in cabin - Bud wrote  
them a note "quiet please  
Ranger on duty, slept half  
Park". Rangly & other ~~wrangler~~  
wrangler took at least  
10 horses up first - then  
Bud & geo parked 3 more  
& dapples afternoon one horse  
Bud went first w. 1 horse  
then geo w. 2 tied to tails  
& brought up rear. Trip  
was through spruce & pine

trail interspersed w. meadows  
Sesomogave but thought  
by horse's arts there was  
something there. Bed rode  
sort of sideways, chattering to  
George - I dropped my jacket  
& Bed had to come get it!  
as I stayed in rear - Walkers are  
all in - Mr. Cooper took my  
duffles to my tent - "Sprout"  
Oliver Everest has cat in front  
two others Ellen Landhalott &  
Sylvia Ates friends from  
Personna on left of tent sharing  
plastic ground cloth - Have  
stone in center of rear - My  
bed parallel to Oliver's - Had tea  
& dinner at 6<sup>30</sup> - Had drink  
in tent as others don't drink  
from small bottle of Johnny  
Walker - good dinner by  
Tillie Richards - See read of  
book for staff - Short song  
fest in doughnut & nitro -

short time. Now very few people in - Everests - Charday, Don, Hawley course - see left  
To bed early & slept right thru.  
Fri July 25 - Trip to Lake  
Lemah I. Crowd started before  
I got down - so went alone.  
One couple had come in  
early & put orange streamers  
on trees to mark trails - I  
met packer bringing horses  
in as I got to junction of  
trail to Lessor & main one  
down the Valley where I  
came in - So I got right  
route - Two others didn't  
& missed bridge (two logs  
& hand rail) Two other  
girls waited for them & they  
went back to bridge - I  
found crowd sitting on  
hillside at lake, two  
campsites at end of lake.

Went on to Continental Divide  
but same bark to eat, few  
people going up mt. to right.  
atd island at end of lake.  
by old log - Wardlaw Joe &  
little boy rode up & went out  
of point of lake - or island  
Some left for home & I followed  
getting in early - first set tea  
Bing-Song at camp, fire -  
Cocoa brought in by Janet  
& L . Slept well  
but roommates are sliding  
down hill on their plastic sheets  
Sat July 26, Trip to Pelleiser  
Pass - I started early, Bob &  
Sylvia followed & would soon  
overtake me. It is 2 miles to  
trail up hillside around debris  
from avalanche, then 2 more  
miles to ascent to Pass - it took  
me 2 1/2 hrs. Then up hill &  
descent to Belyeuse Lake

which is on Alberta side &  
drains north. Saw 2 girls  
on hillsides & they said Pass  
wasn't far - I thought they  
went up & not down trail so  
I went up too - Came out on  
long rising slope to several  
view points - pictures - Saw  
Ranger Joe + son on trail below  
Bushwhacked down to lake  
expecting to find crowd eating  
lunch. No one around so I  
walked back to lake & ate mos-  
quitoes - Left Hike tag on tripod  
of sticks & wrote "See you  
at tea" on trail - Then  
started home hoping leader  
whoever he was, would not  
worry - Ranger came by  
as I got to first stream. Had  
seen my tag - Soon after  
Tom Rodgant + 8 yr old Bill  
appeared - Tom handed me  
Hike tag so no one else saw it.

Came down west of way with them - got off trail once, because of ~~second~~ trail to left - brought us nearer to the horses than we had been on ascent. They were grazing by stream in meadow. Found orange warbs; easily - very hot trip through willow bushes - good breeze every so much often which was refreshing. Little Bill counted 22 frogs (probably toads) on the trail to near camp we saw a ptarmigan with 3 or 4 chicks. They flew up into a tree - got to camp about 5 pm - hot & tired will rest tomorrow. Long sing at camp fire. Birthday for Emmett & Tilla with a cake at cocoa time Sun. July 27 Rest day - lay in bed a lot of the time - bathed then covered myself with 6-12. Por & others in but did not appear

for tea at lunch - I went to  
cook tent & Tiffie & Anne etc  
etc gave me tea etc. They  
were cooking big pans of pem  
for supper - walked down  
trail to get picture of party  
coming in - Anne etc & kids  
arrived then many hikers  
who had gone down to Raunes  
cabin - Stunt night - our  
tent discussed subjects but  
couldn't agree - I thought dis-  
cussion about goats would be  
good but others knew nothing  
about goats! so that fell through  
One day's stunt put 14 people  
on the floor w. head on other  
person's stomach - Then all  
said Haka Haka 1 to 14 times!  
mon July 28 Breakfast to be  
~~at 8 AM~~ with bags down be-  
fore - Everests woke us at  
6 AM. Much too early I knew

but got up at 6:20 - Olive rolled  
my two bags for me & Charlie  
carried them down to Douglaston.  
What a pile of duffel it was.  
Saw Bud weighing it out for  
each horse - Everything ready  
by 7:20 am & we stood around  
around by the fire - afterwards  
I started at 8:40 am - over-  
taken by my trail mates - Olive  
with me - Took off jacket as crowd  
passed me & inadvertently  
left field glasses on trail  
Turned back but one of the girls  
had them - Traveled up one  
slope, crossed to next - ref & cross  
again - Fiveview points & took  
pictures - Avalanche lilies were  
over but covered slopes - must  
be spectacular in season -  
At French - not much - too dry  
at top w. large group sitting by  
rock - off trail en route down

when I followed several who  
started early. Had to come  
down steep slope & down to  
High Horizon Camp - Had  
talk w. Bernie who was  
in tent - Lots of streams to  
cross - one that changed course  
often - but bridges of logs  
flattened were good - About  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  mile to High Hor. cars  
6 of them - those on to Saw  
mill - lots of empty houses -  
mud lake & bogs. At least  
two miles - 13 mi. bus. ate  
orange - very steep - bumpy  
ride down to ~~Cave~~ more  
water works quite interesting  
Road came along Spree  
Reservoir - arrived at  
depot & first bus had just  
got there in too : our driver  
must have come down faster -  
greeted by olive & others -

walked to Dr. H. who was home  
then took car - went to White's  
for Deeney, perched - Tim &  
met Flemings & Dr. Neville  
told Mary to call See about  
leaving at 8:20 AM - They are  
at Spruce Grove Motel as they  
couldn't get in at Red Carpet.  
Got next 36 film - Back to  
depot & got bags helped by Bud  
& Dauder - To Red Carpet where  
Polly was - & Eileen & Rose  
drode up & the Flemings  
Bailed car up so bags came  
out easily - Reshuffled duffle  
took back - ate w, E, & T at  
Homestead after drink their  
rest - cold wind on street  
Had asper on wash again at  
dinner - Back to room & set  
alarm for 6:30 AM.  
Tues July 29. Packed up. Polly  
took her bags to Brown motel

Flew over Verandery mt &  
Monarch Ridge

last night - Parked car &  
then it wouldn't start.  
Thought it was wet, phoned  
Standish Service (thinking  
it was wet from public  
places in motel) ordered  
breakfast & tow-truck was  
there five ten minutes or  
less - And I had left gear  
in reverse - ~~Get~~ foolish  
flemings were at Daves  
Sue drove us to compound,  
we took off - Jim to take  
my car back gave him  
spare keys - I sat in front  
came over very light fast  
Saw road to Sussie &  
of course parking lot - over  
Pootenay & then we were  
there  $\Sigma$  can see lake, cabin  
A frame & tent - Photo class  
from school there, led by  
Bruce Egler & Bob

Pfeiff - Have A Bldg. plus  
one that which Pfeiff had.

Rick & girls put up new  
tent wh has cedar poles +  
fly - Too small for four.  
so Polly + I took yellow  
tent, wh Pfeiff was using  
got settled - after lunch we  
four went up valley, climbed  
to col at end slightly to the  
right - Windy there but a  
screen of bushes gave pro-  
tection. Then back on trail  
along hill side - when we got  
to the line, Margt. found she  
had lost her hat - She + Polly  
went back, Hilda sat on trail  
I, cold + tired came home - down  
ridg bed to trail - blue tent  
there + seen three people were  
had hats up further - To camp  
& rest. others found hat, +  
Hilda came in later. Drink

bark of our tent - good dinner  
& sat by small camp fire  
& chatted - Bed early & had  
a wet night - Polly's side  
quite wet - nine o'clock other  
tent leaks, they say in  
seams - I slept pretty well.

Wed July 30 Rain - Sat  
in cabin most of day - wrote  
diary - Marmot like spruce  
dog sleep under A frame  
nest blue named Siri + has  
eight pups - Girls made choc  
cookies + we had tea in  
cabin - Polly gone for a walk  
Rain off + out all day - Polly  
down trail for 45 min. wet  
most of the way home - we have  
drinks on big log bark of our tent  
Hennings have Hunting Sherry + Polly  
& I Johnny Walker - Hennings tent  
leaked but Rick put plastic over  
it - Sleeping pretty well & generally

Thurs. July 31 - Looks as if clearing but  
cloudy. Voted for short trip + back for  
lunch - Led by Rick. we four went  
around to the bowl back of outlier  
of Norman Mt. good deal of red  
hill gouging. Lunch of soup etc in  
cabin - Rain in off. Took nap wrote  
diary etc - we sat at small center  
table in cabin - Sometimes Rick eats  
with us, sometimes just us four. Photog-  
raphers eat in A Bldg. Debby takes it  
over + they wash own dishes. girls seem  
to do it all easily. Sit around small  
fire in eve. My camera wouldn't reel  
back + came apart again - Rick + then  
Bruno worked to put it together - pesky  
so tiny it is hard to do. Went getting  
damp. Must close bottom zippers  
to keep rain out. Bruno says the  
weather is changing! but how?  
Fri Aug 1 Swiss holiday - The girls  
put Swiss flag on Brunos duvel - we  
are off to fossil bed - Route is up

Valley to col where we went on Tues  
aft, then up to ridge - hard pull  
& I thought of going back - too far to  
fossil beds & back by same route.  
Margaret might go with me but  
I suggested we go down one of the  
shale slopes straight to Valley.  
Rick didn't know how we were  
on shale & rocks - but that's what  
we did - nice walking on ridge  
wide & flat. Large spectacular  
colours on right going right down  
long distance - <sup>one to see</sup> large rocks stand  
on end - Rick calls them tombstones  
Had to climb two rocky summits  
on way to fossil bed near snow  
bank - One viewpoint there but  
valley fairly shut in - Fossils mostly  
~~coral~~ - spongy ones - brought down  
two - one with core which is quite  
prominent - Rick has collection on  
work there - Brought home what  
Margaret said were brachiopods

will show them to Dr. Link - Came down shale + stream bed - Rock ahead, then I Hilda Mary + Polly - No trouble - shale was soft enough - no slips - Siri roamed everywhere + hunted gophers - down way ahead of us - Into valley + down trail - Met Debby with six of the puppies - picking flowers - Flowered but I didn't put on raincoat - Had tea in cabin + then I fell asleep in tent - Polly woke me at 6 PM! Sat Aug 2 Rain in night &  
then it seemed warmer Sat in  
cabin & wrote diary - Photographers  
carried lots of their gear out as they  
leave tomorrow & they have lots  
of heavy cameras plates & developper  
stuff - 1 1/2 hrs drive to Radium or

Fri July 9. Clouds down. Sun out for few minutes about 10. Wrote diary. Got list of staff from Marsha. Valerie vacuumed upper floors (assisted by Marika) Ben Bertynau was to climb today on Practice Cliff w. A.C.C. people & then go to Caumore Club House & training camp week w. A.C.C. Almost 11 & Sun trying to come out - went around lake & watched climbers on the cliffs - Have rope up & doing smooth looking cliff - older man there with Ben & 2 girls - were here last year. Lunch alone rest & read. down Cataract Brook only a bit. Girls planned they were at Chateau & O'Hara bus was at Post. Trixie straightened that out.

waited for 4 girls in my room.  
But they sneaked in without  
my seeing them - Have Room  
# 4 Polly & May - # 6 Clara & Sylvia  
Had ice for them & happy hour  
in my room, crowded a lot -  
Am working on my cold but  
coughing & blowing disagreeably  
often - Have no appetite - Have  
barbecue outside w. great big  
steaks - pit built out in front.  
However most every body came  
inside - Steak & all keeping too  
much for me - waste a lot -  
Sat. July 10. Walk around the lake  
w. rowboats etc. - Sylvia interested  
in birds. Few are singing probably  
because of weather. Girls say  
there are mosquitoes but I haven't  
felt one! all in for lunch. Walked  
down road in sun one aft. then  
down steep trail to stream just  
at bridge & up to Lower Lake. Saw

2 female harlequin ducks around  
point by western cabin - slow  
in eve. got good seat by friend,  
girls (who?) slow very peppy.  
Mrs Hatters Party - Songs original  
& otherwise. Nick lived all in  
hiking boots. met Megan's sister  
Lorna Whittingham. Megan was  
married two months ago & is now  
in N.Z. or was it Australia? were  
live around here & Nick - one was  
in audience wanted to take my  
picture but begged off.

Sun July 11 Went to Mary Lake  
with all 4 girls. Clara has had  
second eye cataract operation  
& doesn't see so well so just one  
eye still. Colors are wonderful.  
Sylvia learning bird calls. White  
wren & ruby cr. Warred through  
Polly & May went up to cabin  
meadows lots of snow. Others  
came back with me via trails.

meadow where girls stopped at  
table at AAC Hut. Rob Mitchell  
there as custodian - I back for  
lunch. When Polly & Day returned  
Polly & I went around lake.

Now July 12. all went to Schoff  
Lake. Lots of snow. I was afraid  
but tracks don't always stick to  
trail - That girls might not make  
it but they did. I scanned lake  
for sandpiper - heard one - also first  
fox sparrow singing - no goats  
but lots of snow would mask  
them hard to spot - couldn't see  
any trails - only snow slides. Wind  
seems cold so I left for lunch at  
Lodge. soup + tea with my sandwich  
much easier coming down trail  
easier to follow. Mitchell gave them  
some of his blueberry pie. He told  
me porcupine had kept him a  
wake all night + he had just gotten  
up. Hut has new roof part way

for stop when trail descends  
what I have called the view-  
pt. Is it? - met girls in 4 min  
coming on slowly. Got to meadow  
in 4.5 min & Lodge in 15 more. Lunch  
& read paper - Rem. Conn. tomorrow  
[6674° Lake O'Hara. altitude 50

"Says Leek - is under water) He  
is discussing Celsius temps treat-  
ings - & chatting. All 4 girls here  
on balcony. wed. 9:30-10 am as  
I write this]

after reading paper I walked around  
lake alone - Sun out - delicious  
& then it rained gently as I

reached the open area near bridge - lots of birds feeding there. To Lodge, change bats - tea - warden here talking w. others about Mt. Arthur Lake said it was seldom clear & brilliant as in picture (Rest. girls came in about 3pm. Had reached Laike Lake & came back by warden's trail. (fire Rd) had difficulty crossing stream. Water high everywhere but trail around lake is drying up. Read a bit & talked. To bed 9<sup>30</sup>. Slept pretty well - but sleep not too good & thorn in my finger. Tired

Wed July 14 Clouds way down wrote diary on balcony. all girls there plus Fred. 2 deer in lake probably male Barrows. have lots of white on them - girls late morning up bed - Sorted duffle to keep packing on Sat.

all five of us in in lecture.  
I went to Wary Lake & looked  
at both parts going down  
both trails - Then back  
to meadow - young couple  
there - I first heard lion  
grunt (like a bear or  
moose?) Back to Lodge  
for bath & rest - girls  
went out later - seen fr.  
Cloudcloud (Blaw) slouch  
pictures of O'Hara etc but  
it wasn't dark enough  
& sheet was used for screen  
To bed after some time  
turned a chair around for  
me - Did not sleep till 2 or 3  
but have been on vitamins  
very last - left box at home

Thursday July 15 Baro-  
meter up & dog looks best  
yet - ordered Guide & girls  
off for vesa, I followed.

later. Met Clara on way down  
had nose bleed & glare was  
bad on eyes. I felt it too  
hard to see. Up past falls,  
met couple coming down.  
Said very friends decided  
not to wait - was glad. Falls  
very full - few birds but

up on rocks, met 3 girls &  
couple who were very nice.  
Ate lunch at oera - Guilles

Friday July 16 - went to  
Spalding, Polly & Nicole  
left Berg ahead & went up to  
Poet's Park & Mission on trails  
in cabin. I decided against  
swell pool as long as Polly had  
a scorpion. Nicole strong  
& fast - Clara, Sylvia & Nancy  
slower & we all climbed on  
flat rock just short of next to  
last lake I shouted to Polly  
that they were too big.  
After lunch I led around the  
point & down along lakes  
not too bad going. Polly & N.  
were home first. Sylvia & I  
just after them & Nancy & Clara  
came much later. All seemed  
to enjoy it. Thick weather  
has really cleared. Got first  
sunburn but no mosquitoes  
yet all the others seemed to  
have seen some & use dope.

Polly, Day met Eileen, Hora  
+ Oglelands about 5:30 PM  
but I didn't know whom  
they were coming - Have  
usual cabins. Oglelands in  
#2. Eileen + Hora in #10  
Have table in back end  
of dining room - Jack Cole  
here for dinner + sat at  
our table. Is at Ace cabin

+ club affairs I chatted w.

Tired + to bed.

Sat July 17. ordered leeches

this am as weather is  
gorgeous. Polly + I to Oderay  
Plateau - very pleasant - Some  
snow on trail up from meadow  
but not hard to get around

warm w. breeze - others came  
to meadow with us but then  
went back & around lake.  
Two men putting green tree  
slabs on cabin roof - Polly rd  
back at 2 pm. - had bathes  
& packed as we leave 9 am  
for Banff & Skylon Hike -  
Dinner in Hilton Hotel!  
Jack here again for dinner  
& asked him up for drink -  
Told him to put his cigarette  
out & come up. More yet. & Club  
talk. He climbed little  
odaray today - up by 11: 20 I  
had looked but didn't see  
him or tracks - After dinner  
chatted with Harry Pitt - got  
down at cabin but I didn't go  
down - Show at 9 P.M. as usual  
Peppy. Some spots quite funny  
& finished packing & wrote  
up this diary -

Sun. July 18. Packed & left  
on 9 am bus. Car ok except I  
have not received my insurance,  
& 21 days were up yesterday;  
into Banff - got lodges at foot H.

Evans & other relatives. Sylvia  
has car. Left notes for them &  
planned Aileen who will have  
dinner with us at Homestead at  
7 PM & drinks at 6 - Laundry  
closed for lunch! must go back  
did errands, films & batteries  
for flash-light (camera shop  
has them) ate at 9 r.w. Lots of  
small tots there as usual. Polly  
& Pay like teen hamburgers - Parked  
on Shady lane to river. Bought  
new seeds - toothbrush at gas-lap.  
Lots of cars on lane when I returned.  
girls walked to Red C. Packed for  
Sunshine & O'Hara - got a good  
rest. Read a bit about Vice P.

chosen by Carter-Bath. Bileen  
came promptly at 6 PM & Dorit  
& Sylvia Evans shortly after  
& stayed for drinks only, good  
dinner - I had fish as usual. Bileen  
drove & went home right after  
I packed taking big duffle & Suit  
Case (mostly books & maps etc) to  
Sunshine. Two buses one at 9:15  
(+ one at aft.) - Joanie in brown  
bag & sl. bag in black leaves  
room in clo etc in sides. Break-  
fast at Adrienne + 8:45 AM at  
Daries - got bags to office at  
Mt. Royal parking place at 9:30  
Prescott had theirs there earlier  
Lou Silberman there - will be on  
fish Hike - Also saw Haus quaser  
mon July 19. Adrienne is  
OK - prompt & good. To Daries  
a bit earlier, time to put on boots  
Gave Sue my extra keys. Jim  
already at "pad" had 7:30 am

job. Sue drove my car & parked it out there. Then came with us. Way in front. I was on sunny side - Polly on other. See in middle - was given "de luxe trip." Sue said wonderful views. Pictures but Polly & I fear lost hers. May have lost mine as I found the back of the camera unlatched. We went up Healy Creek. Saw new parking spot for trailers (?) over very high cols. Couldn't see too much in front or my side. Landed by lovely little lake near Divide but not where I camped years ago (1934) Jim & Sue stayed with us for 50 mins or more taking pictures etc. Half built cabin there w. huge logs - heard later trapper built it & wardens wouldn't let him finish it. Lovely site on lake shore. View of mountains.

+ Brundaff - Geoposed about  
mt gloria + mt aurora - Jim took  
off w. Sue (she hadn't planned to  
go) - Then we went up slope +  
over ridge - Polly in lead - went  
further down into valley than  
the trail we used later from camp.  
guess we were on game trail -  
our times - To meet Jim at 8:45 AM  
at Marvel Pass Lodge at 9:35 - then  
till 10:25 - Told it was 35 min to  
camp but we took twice as long.  
1 hr 10 min - of course only stop  
in camp - we had ordered sand-  
wiches at Adriennes - In tent eating  
Tongue - Long way to biffies but  
our trail came in there - Long  
wait till biffies + park train arrived  
one of Polly's duffle in + she fixed  
her bed - Tent stopped as usual  
stox & bumps - Thought we would  
have it in tent but found we were  
alone - Fine - Park came in

about 4:30 or 5 - Hiked a bit afterwards & slow go later - Cook is Tillie Richards. Janet & Corinne Brewster & Jerry LaMottes brother. He & Corinne built us a fire w. Nag's matches. Can't find mine. Camp fire in Donut & Skimpy & cold late. They now light it with blow torch. Found it more difficult to sit bed - feet cold so used space blanket on foot. Nag thought she didn't sleep & we all slid on our mattresses.

Tues July 20 Signed up for trip back to Marvel Pass. Started to snow on leading - went to same lake, then scrambled around it. Lunch on high bank - very windy but we found shelter little puddle of water below us. After lunch went to viewpoint & then past cabin on circling the lake - good views - I took

upper trail + missed cabin but I  
saw it yesterday - Back by ribbon  
over ridge + down on very good  
but narrow trail - Lots of singing  
at camp fire - 2 musicians with  
guitars + one crooner - One man  
could play flute but music  
mostly too wild + sometimes in-  
credible - To bed + slept well.

Wed July 21 Day + I went to  
owl lake - Everyone but us three  
had come in that way - Polly  
back to marvel + special view-  
point beyond - Mary Betts  
widow of Bea Betts (Acc) came  
too + 4 or 5 fishermen party  
were ahead - Saw them at owl  
lake but we continued around to  
outlet which was crammed with  
logs - Probably from avalanches  
slopes above - But let under-  
ground - Mary Betts returned  
+ I hope joined fishermen - Very

+ I landed in nice spot  
near water + protected from  
wind - I had worried about  
crossing outlet! all under-  
ground - By the map we saw  
we had to cross 2 streams but  
decided to try it - Sat under  
dry tree as storm started but  
with no signs of stopping we  
waited on a good trail near  
lake - narrow but distinct.  
All seemed well when we  
came upon a fast stream  
cascadeing down + protected  
by willows - Rain + a wet  
drop on every leaf - Too thick  
to go upstream - One log across  
probably put there by fisher-  
men + would have dared  
cross it. Both decided we'd go  
back as we came - long pull  
very wet - My rain jacket  
trapped down my neck + very

green Lourie pants soaked  
Colt + wet as we trudged back.  
I took my wet topo off + put on  
my sweater + Nays very wet  
stuff in plastic bag wh.  
Day carried - was really  
colder than as there was  
stiff wind - Polly had fire  
going and a lot of people  
were soaked - weather not  
too good for tomorrow

Thurs July 22 I stayed in  
all day & it went quickly  
Nay also - Allison Brevoort  
gave us tea bags & we had  
tea at our lunch. Amelle  
3 girls, Bed all in camp.  
Bed had two bridges built  
one over camp stream down  
near Owl Lake; one over the  
stream N + I couldn't cross but  
maybe 2 miles up. Polly went  
to new lake up that draw  
led by Lou Sherman who

didn't know trail & she said  
she was glad Day & I had  
not gone & were not home  
till after 5. no camp fire on  
eve - Dorothy had night off.  
Fri. July 23 Stan Thompson  
leading trip to same lake  
& I decided to go as far as  
the two bridges. Ceded by  
going whole way. Stan a  
good leader - Dor Hawkes &  
Jim Ainsley (?) said never  
& I at end too. Trail leads  
off to right to cross camp  
stream not far from owl lake.  
Then around owl lake to  
steep switchbacks up to and  
around steep sheer rock  
wh. a lot of people spoke of - to stop <sup>the</sup>  
trail around lake. Gov't waste  
blast trail there but never did.  
It's a "feature" if inconvenient &  
I think it would be pity to dyna-  
mite it. Both bridges had hand

rails - up steep hill afterwards  
& lost crowd but there was only  
one way "up" - Reached highest  
ridge & short way down to lake  
Crowd there - much water fr. lake  
afterwards walked to middle  
point of lake - pictures - Stan's wife  
dressed in similar jacket to his  
is Barbara (?) looks like him - all  
started home - 4 of us on good trail  
working along side of hill but going  
down too. Stan appeared - said  
it would bring us out at owl lake  
not at Bud's bridge - metette, Telle  
& others on horseback at bridge when  
we got there - Tired & slow on way  
home - met Sonn here & fishing  
& Walter had caught 3 or 4 - Babe etc  
carried my rucksack home - left  
it in my tent - hire of her - They are going  
to Assin after camp. (tomorrow) & will  
be at Sunshine on the 28<sup>th</sup> - STurt  
Bright & Ev. Boyd had good verses  
re owls of owl lake - great

variety of stunts. Tent cold &  
Dor. Hawkes went & got me blanket.  
It took sometime to warm the  
blanket up! To bed & fussed more  
than usual.

Sat July 24 were to meet Davies &  
Abode at 9:45 AM at lake where he/  
landed us - Polly up at 6 am - I at  
6:30 Packed up & had breakfast  
in cook tent at 7:30 off at 8:15  
Picture taking of us 3 by several  
people - Trail goes by cliffs &  
& stopped there & They were long  
way up from tents! Also fire  
with coffee far from eating fly.  
Sonnbieris<sup>s</sup> passed us en route  
to Marvel Pass & Assin where  
they are staying 4 nights & then  
hiking to Sandstone where  
we will see them - We got to slope  
above lake when we heard James  
helicopter & we got to landing strip  
as he came in! Both were early.  
See & Margaret grocer with

Sun - They were going to camp  
at three - Laj R was at dinner for  
several days - we took off soon  
I in front seat. Flew over Allegheny  
Pass & Verm. Lakes. It's all so quick  
one doesn't take it all in - Saw  
the 10 mile but not half-way - missed  
that. Landed at pad of my car  
& went outside gate. Jim took off  
his truck to get picture of Morgan  
who was in Indian Day Parade  
was on horse, back of duck wagon.  
En route to Red Carpet we saw only  
fire engines, cars & crowds. Came  
in back way after Sec. tries! Got  
Polly & Kays things at Por. H's Book  
w. Trillie - Por H & Sylvia Evans  
off w. relatives sight seeing & won't  
be back till late - Left note for  
them to come to dinner at Home-  
stead & Red Carpet at 6 P.M. (with  
Sherry Dorothy") Proceeded

some repacking, rest. At 3 PM  
went to Mt Royal's parking lot.  
Quicker there. I mailed film  
truck w. bags from Hile came  
in & we got ours as they were  
taken off truck. Unpacked & I  
took my bags. Joanie & bedbox  
to Dor H. She wasn't home yet  
but she & Sylvia turned up at  
6 PM in driects <sup>only</sup> w. ies. Also Oileen  
who drove the 3 of us to Homestead  
Prescott's treated a. + me. Parked in  
eve & decided to take suitcase  
(mostly records + desk stuff) &  
big duffle to Sunslime -  
Got laundry in at fr. Pearl. It's  
closed for lunch but too late  
to take Hile's stuff there - Is in  
small duffle in back of car. Also  
Polly & Hail's things - Trunkless  
parked in eve & went to bed.  
Fairly early - Room has thermus:  
stat - radiator blasting out cold air  
& also discovered window was open

Sun. July 25 - Bus to Sunriser

Then walked to Rock Isle  
Lake over hill side in stiff  
breeze - I suddenly decided  
I'd had enough & turned back  
no wind! But I hadn't stopped  
I just didn't mind it on back.  
One couple passed + party with  
dog who were on bobs - walked  
around houses on return - rented  
girls came in little later. good  
dinner \$7 or \$8! Special is \$6 = Happy  
hour in sit room. Bed early - Shower
