waited for bus to arrive
with Ethne Gale Gibson -

I ordered a jelly sandwich
others had cheese + lettuce

Dor's. - Sylvia scouted a
trail in am + then came
back + took us up fr view
of Swinson meadows and
long line of five peaks. We
passed the reservoirs - 2 later
wh. supply the water. wonder
how they do it in winter? Sylvia
says they bring water from
Rock Isle! Hikers coming
out, saw robins + rosy finches +
heard raven(?) on way home.
stiff wind high up. Lunch in
line of bushes. comfortable spot.
Then down a bit to fine view pt.
I took last picture w. cap on!

and found I had no extra
film - missed fine views
of peaks - Mt. Ball + others
+ those around Haiduk (?) map
too small an area - Home in
time for rest - shower +
drunk - Had salmon + dinner
others the \$⁰⁰ stew - looked
good - A.T.V in basement
reported to have Olympics
on at 8 P.M but I came up to
read + do diary - To bed early.
It's raining so didn't go to
see the shop in the old bldg.
open in eve. Had film in safe case.

Tues July 27. Clouds down + it
snowed last night or early
this AM - Tired + decided to
stay in - had rest day - writing
diary in sitting room. When
Aileen Harmon appeared - was
with Gertrude Smith - They went
off to Rock Isle Lakes + were
join the others - finished diary

to here - Had lunch in dining room - Soups & chicken & baking with rice & lots of gravy - O'Keefe's Susan green came in & joined us - she had salad only - we talked of our trips to N. Norway & to Yukon & Alaska - was in Wally's Box - She has just learned to ski & is crazy about - Has full year job in charge of reservations - one month off w/ pay - is at Sunslive whole year has car & can drive up road - Mrs Ford got her job through Jolie goes Girls Olympic ski team here with instructor coach - They exercise all year to keep muscles in trim Susan's car stuck & she left with two other girls - I was writing letter when girls came in & they had missed Aileen & Dorothy so did they see the couple who came in with them - All had tea together in dining room & Dorit had delish chocolate cake - Dr

Robinson + Mrs. R. came in too +
Aileen introduced them - He is
son of Dr. R. in Baerff years ago.
Told him her his father pulled
me through pneumonia in 1950 -
He said they did a good job! The
couple (she is a friend of Ev. Kort-
house + was at dinner with me then
last year) left to waes down.
Robinsons, Aileen + Gertrude
took bus - Japanese tour in the
evening occupying 4 or stables
we went to the Slop - Eskimo
stuff - ski equip - nothing I
wanted - Herve & V. + we watched
olympics for a bit - horse jump
good - pickups very high - Judo
+ boxing so I left to read - Radar
sleep well -

Wed July 28 Looks cloudy -
Ethne to leave on 10 am
bus - then by bus to Van from
4:30 PM to 10 or 12 tomorrow
but she doesn't mind one ~~or~~

Wright & can sleep - Dailey is
taking secretarial course & also
looking for job - is 23 yrs. old. We
five then started off to keep out
of wind - Sylva leads we wound
up hills to look over at Healy
Creek - good view of mt. Assin.
in balds all day - but Major
& Terrapin clear - Mt. Quartz
Hill stands out in front of Assin.
Lunch in lee of clump of trees & boxes
lay 2 pm - ottis was having tea
while I write this. Sitting room
wide & warm but our rooms
(Dorit & I) coolish. Have man up to
see - said he had trouble w. heat
below - Took shower - awful or-
deal - was hot or cold, doesn't seem
slippery - cold when you get out - high
Rest while Dor. showered - plastic
bag over her arm in case (she fell
on her front steps almost 2 yrs ago)
She gets on very well - except for
buttons, sb. strap fasteners & laces.

Happily home at 5:30 - Dor. + Syloria
drinking sherry. Took lump clumps
for dinner - were too well done
but gave me 4 - no dessert - Throat
feels dry + developed into sore throat
in late eve. gargled w/ aspirin - Took
Bauff aspirin about 11 pm + slept till 6.
Thurs. July 29. Have cold + after
some discussion took Dr. Mills
anti biotics - marked 190 - after
breakfast Dor. moved up to Syloria's
room - Read + wrote diary in
settling room. Dor + Syloria had tea
or coffee or saunta in lounge.
Walter + Babette soon came
in last night about 5 PM - had
dinner here, chatted with us for a
while - left this eve on early bus
to go to Skoki - Sat a lot in settin'
room, read Time, Newsweek +
Ushews. May ordered newspaper
Others went out in aft - mostly
rain - my room cold but friendly,
they have gotten it fixed

July 30. Tonight 4 anti-biotics
pills a day - after each meal +
one about 12 midnight - my room
now warm - girls went out in AM
but it rained in aft. I rested -
was sick some time - Don't come
down in shower in my room as
upstairs one was smaller. There
are Olympics movies at 8-9 +
Spring pictures at 9 or 9:30 I pre-
fer to read - girls are three
times as I write this 8:30 PM Pd
bills + answered appeals for funds.
Hitlers are coming in constantly.
Two girls sat next table - seem
Sofia - Olympic team here
w. coach for most meals (girls)
Cliff White around - His wife
took too many sleeping pills
+ his daughter has disappeared
Is the one who dear clearing
fled years ago - very tragic how
cold lots better but appetite
is poor - Had chicken tonight

went to mail letters & stopped & saw
one movie of R.M. Rainesightings &
inland bales & manas

Sat July 31. West still low but it
wicht - went to breakfast asked girl
if I was first & she said no, the last.
Friends of Phyllis Hart's at next table -
Don't know their names & of them; one
who looked familiar said they would
be at O'Hara Aug 30 - Then met my
gang about to go out with lunches - aim
for Simpson Pass but Sylvia doubts

Ridderich Pass which is west also on divide.
Sun came out & I walked on the
walk outside our windows - Read
news magazines - Cold seems gone
thea eatherab comes back - over
sitting room warm sometimes
too warm - Breezy in dining room
at lunch - Waitress said she could
not feel it - Tour of Japs arrived
Sat on lawn & around the hole
there w. big boulders - Dalton
friend of Aileen said they
ate lunch brought to them there
w. chop sticks - I wished for cana
era but hesitate to go take them

Aileene H. had come in in the
form of me in sitting room - was
with Dalton - A girl-taking
black pictures - They came
back for tea or coffee & we sat
in lounge - He was very nice
& we gotten very well Aileene
as a social misconception -
where they went - separately - why
& what they got - He couped - got
cups over the counter etc & girls
came in about 5:30pm but Polly
& I had gone fr. Simpson Park
towards Hobart & when
others came home had come
by Rock Isle lake to get pictures
as her first ones were lost.
They brought me a drink &
that ended our scotch
All tired & to bed early - we
paid our bills as we leave
tomorrow on 10 am bus - Slept
well & am packed up.

Sun Aug 1. Polly got us all to
the front coffee at least 20 min
before time - A Jap tour there
to take our bus & we get priority
there tour got on - I had chance over
director - a girl - who checks -
pays for all washing out & paying
driver - As we were in front
seats, we saw & heard all
very interesting - At bus station
Polly & Kay looked after baps &
Sylvia & I went for ears look
parked back of D's apt - all
Started & K also Sylvia feared
hers wouldnt - Also she had
hole & crack in her windshield
from stone - She plowed Celeen
& we purchased hamburgers
etc from Q + W, & all ate on
Celeen's porch - She is painting
her house - has ladders etc
but her porch has curings to keep
off sun & it was fairly com-
fortable - Polly & I doctored

fruit at whites (she cherries etc
& bananas) we then checked
me in at Red Carpet. Room 104
They hand bags beautifully
& I took them to bus stop for
Calg. bus at 3:30 - The bus here
would leave bags across at
the but Royal Parking Lot so I went
over - Two men there were very
cordial (Did they know me?) &
I sent messages to Jack Cross-
ley (re Point fire) & to the
Everests all of whom are on
3rd Hippo - Said 2nd was about
like first - Returned to see Polly
reading in sta. & had my bags.
Said goodbye & went to Red
Carpet. Room 104 - wh I had
earlier this summer - Found
note fr. Pam - about Deutish after
10 am mon. wh is some kind of
holiday - Had sherry at Dr. H's
& then to Homestead for dinner
Dr. treating Sylvia & Dr. H. Hadley

good lamb & D. had pie & dessert
Came to my apt & watched his-
tory of olympics - dramatized e-
vents of past games on my T.V.
Had never used it before but Sylva
ran it - left at 9 pm - It's not quite
dark then but cars have their
lights on. They walked home
Said she'd like to & D. reluctantly
won Aug 2. went to audience
for breakfast - Stopped to tell
Pam I'd be there at 10 am - An
emergency occurred - a woman
who had tooth out in pain - Service
delay - got two mouthfuls of
plaster - almost choked me
laid out flat - Dr. Barker very
calm & soothing but how
can one sleep w. two liglets in
one eye, a syphon in your mouth
& other thick? gave me a
new novocaine stuff & left
for 15 min! An ordeal from
10-12 but he says I'll have

one fine took wh will be,
there when others are all gone!
Did errands, & at 1:30 or so
had dinner at Suntex.
Girl said it was earned well
good! Repaid & forced
from Gilken to coffee at 6pm
to dinner - Stopped at 8 or 9
but saw no car so forced
them at 9 as when I got there
Had good steaks but hard to
choose - boiled potatoes vegetable
a good bonee cooked dinner
ice cream & peaches for dessert
Showed us films of the Scold
or young related trip. Beautiful
pictures without any com-
mentary. Sylva in one
of them or more - Left at 8:45
to get home before lights are
on. Slept better & like room
Tues. Aug 3. Breakfast at
Aardvark - Lots of cars on
Beauf Ave - had to park

up by Harmons - Service quick -
good food - Lots of diners there
Went to Insurance Co & policy
had been mailed to O'Hara
Did lot of errands - nut & bolts
Bauhaus - hair off at 3 pm.
Chocolate cookies for numerous
teas at O'Hara - Bauhaus, Legion
Stopped at Dor H & She went
to BSH for lunch at snack
bar - had ham & cheese sandwich
Sandwich & I had hamburger
& milk shake - very good.
Toured BSH - Lots of boutiques
Do they sell much? Need
the complete round - Flowers
lovely & some new spots
w. flowers on terrace - Has
one parking place w. charge
a lot without - was lucky as
3 girls pulled out of car as
I drove ~~out~~ up - got hair
done at 3 pm by Betty.
Went to see Mary alone

Steward at 439 Muskrat
as I had plonned her several
times - nobody home - She
has left Arkansas - Saw Capt.
Whyte who Said she & Eldon
Walls were dissatisfied - W-a
didn't check travelite w. B of
D. & W-a resigned - I have
tried to plonnd her but no luck
got rest - tried & lost in town
had ice cream after hair-do
at Audreunes - Then rest
in Red Carpet 104 - bath &
drink coffee - Wrote diary to
7:30 P.M. - Got pancakes at Smuttys
but they weren't cooked enough
Had indigestion that night - Am nearly
packed to make I can get away to
Louise & 11 am bus at gate.

Wed Aug 4 Woke early & got up be-
fore 7 AM - must be Polly's influence
Breakfast at Audreunes - its just as
good as B.C & waitress (wife of owner)
just as good as Libra - Harmon's open

at 9 am & I wanted bi-so-dol &
hydrogen peroxide - went back to
Red Carpet - packed up - my duffle
heavy to lift but I did to put it
on back seat - Suitcase in back.
Returned to Harmon's for drugs & R.
Went by Route 1 as traffic was not
too bad - made Chateau while
O'Hara Bus was there - found
Richard at Info Desk in line w.
4 or 5 people - waited by car till he
came out & transferred my bags &
took overcoat, tie & umbrella.
Went to gate - lots of cars & people,
when bus came it was almost
full - Two (day trippers) made res-
ervations. Richard yesterday -
One worked at Chateau & was
showing his sis' Lake O'Hara.
Second bus passed on road driven
by girl (new to me) - In Room #
blugs brought ruined lately - un-
painted a bit - Asked for table by
wall near serving table - no draft

No sun & near breakfast needs - no
one else likes it - Marous Lee - she
had had cold - Tommy did too - also
Minetta Pesslers husband - lots of
others speak to me - Ask about His-
tories - Only 4 Moraine Lake ones
left at Book & Art Den when I asked.
Walked around lake in aft. after
I opened mail & one box of pictures
12 8-listed & dotted - nice pictures
of 8 girls in Meadow. Got some
rain as I crossed bridge - Back
& rest - tea - Drink w. Link on bal-
cony - other couple there had
drunk their own - but finally
joined in conversation - Are
they in Room 3? Read paper
after dinner, sitting next to Max in
good light & passed chair on to
Lester when I went to bed at 10.

Thursday 5. Mist way down.
Wrote letters all am - after lunch
wrote diary - Barbara Estrand
here - has 3 children - friend

has 2 - Think they need a stay nur-
sery: A grizzly w. 3 cubs. at-
tacked & killed a goat & injured
a man badly at Baloo Pass at
glacier - now signs are posted
& one grizzly was seen at Mac-
Arthur Pass (or creek) & she also
has 3 for cubs - Tourists are
warned to be on lookout for her.
Those at Baloo Pass were killed
cubs & all - Larry & Mary Mac
Kenzie is here - Also Ian Roote
Lots of people out but much still
down. 1:15 pm Ian Roote has bad
eye & must be careful so came with
grandparents - Aarons daughter
coming next week - Rested, read
book I had banana from Banff in-
stead of tea. Joddy West & 2
friends are at camp ground. Saw
them as they looked over the balcony
pictures - Had drink alone in room
watched the six children during
dinner - Each in turn ran to

mann for comfort & assurance when
some one got lost or feel very ex-
musing - Chatted w. Marg. MacKenzie
in eve - Lots of people here greet
me & talk of history now out of print

Friday Aug 6. West way down
But nice - some blue sky - A
baby bat on floor in girls bath
room last night - I asked mother
if he wanted new pet? Says since
new roof was put on, bats can't get
in under eves - some have moved
to cabins - Wrote diary - Walked
around lake - goats below lower
gap - 13 or more have been seen.
one on ivy & one big one on cedaray,
Mr Johnson toldly west & his
& pals climbed "middle" peak
of cedaray - got picture at 20' ft.
Rip west has bad knee - may not
be able to walk much - Tragedi were
to have come but another couple
took their reservation - Omellet
for lunch - a good many eggs

for me as one dish is always
cheese. Most went to a picnic
meadow & past 2 little lakes. One
good raft thru by shore - other
two big square logs at rear end
in mud. Return to Hidden Lake
much lower than in July & then
to Mary Lake - took 1st trail - no
ducks. Then back to Lodge. Tired
& no pop. Bath & tea - rest. Estrands
& at next table - Pearleaux
here in cabin. Also gardeners. Jim
J. back at Horatio Lake studying
erosion of rock slides. Don is
Baffin Island, is archaeologist -
fisherman on lake this AM turned
out to be Guy Everett - is at
ACC Hut. Bear Club has 8 year
lease - charge non members \$3⁰⁰
members \$1. Read in we're talked
to hearing Aaron & Marg. MacKenzie -
going to bed early but don't always
sleep well - using Buuff aspirin
occasionally.

Sat Aug 7. quite clear at 5 am -
but started clouding up by break-
fast. Decided to go out but didn't
want to carry heavy rain gear.
Went to Big Lake trail leaving
at 10 am. Saw one of the others moving
ahead of me - heard tingling bells.
It may have been Marq bear II.
They were en route to MacArthur
Lake. It started raining by 11 am
although there was blue sky in west.
I had just climbed the steepest part.
Had head cover only. Reached Schaffer
Lake by 11:15 cut across to down trail
& reached Lodge by 12:10 - wet but
not soaked. It really rained
then. Soup + tortato + bacon sand-
wich for lunch. Late banana in room.
Rest or slept 2 hrs. Tea + my own
cookies. Tommy Luik asked Tim up
for drink. girl there descended
of oven (not oven) joined in con-
versation & ended by giving Tommy
bottle of Scotch half full. Show

in eve - very peppy but not as "high class" as in former years. The children (& strong) sat on floor in front - very near the fire line. The kitchen fan was on till 12 so went down & found one upon there who turned it off - mist down -

Sun. Aug 8 mist way down. Lodge is full & I sat last night and this AM with MacNeived - I am glad caught two "big" fish - trolling from boat & had them for breakfast - wrote diary - got info re guides from Lick who had letter from Edw Terry dated 1960. See back of this book. Stayed in all day & miss the exercise. Reading Time issue - geo Wash. on front dated 1789 Sept 6 - all cheese dishes for lunch. So ate mostly potato salad (cousin ugly) & toast - vegetable platter all raw - carrots, cucles, olives - Had cookies in room - wrote lots of letters & cards. Long talk after tea w. "Smitty" gardiner. Resonated story of Chas. H. Carter & the

work! To Pearlmaras cabin 6 for cocktails at 5³⁰ w. Leek; gardiners there too. Had good talk w. Mrs. G. Read after dinner & to bed 9:15 - Children continue to amuse me - at table near nine - Visitors are here -

Mon Aug 9. Lots of rain in night & most way down in AM - worst summer I've ever known. Finished 1789 time.

Autographed a history of O'Hara for Mrs. Gerard - wrote diary on upstairs sofa. Lind working on O'Hara ways. Walked around lake wearing plastic raincoat - only one small spell of heavy rain - oyel feeding almost grown young by cabin stream - 2 lakes below eagle cliff en route to Abbot's Pass. Slept in & had omelet w. shrimps - afterwards started for meadow & there was a brief shower - stopped at cabin - custodian was climbing. All bags there & one could be occupied - man & 2 girls came as I left - Back by Mariposa Lake trail & then Sled graves high trail to access on lake

Linn & Geo. guests
Linn & Woodburn has cleared trail to it, don't
have to bushwhack to it now - Bath &
rest - so comfortable I didn't get up for tea.
Smitty Gardner asked Linn & me to
cocktails - cabin II - Pleasant time
after dinner, read paper until people
came to take - Pearlmaus there - She is
doing cover for buck - pine design but
harder than needlepoint - Recommended
Assim & Cath. Lakes to Pearlmaus. Mock
were at Luttrell this year - To bed 9:30.
Had postal fr. Linn & Geo. is coming to
Banff in Aug. - Sends her postal to tell
him of new regulations & bad weather.
Tues Aug 10 mist way down but
Linn said his barometer rose quite a bit.
All dishes at lunch are cheese
So Douna (+ Tony too & Uncle) brought
me plain omelet - Eggs for 2 meals!
Thank you for kitchen shades over bath
tub & plumbing - Can hear it in my
room - put on at 4 pm - Message
fr. Paul Perrin - Dr. Borders has crown
for my tooth. Have appt. Tues 17th

bed Feb 11 - Aileen arrived on 8:30
Am bus came in with gallaghers
Fran, their 2 boys & 3 of her nephews
To be at camp ground one night
Also Madeline Everett who came w.
Sue to Caetley at 8:30; Pat Lever
who works at Mt. Holidays. They
Know Barbara Carroll who is at
table for four where I am temporarily
sitting - all go to mesa, maybe over
ledges or waterfall. Barbara C. has
bought vacation house at Cañoncito
walked around lake, then down
stream to camp site where bees
had just arrived - Reindeer on top
handing down baggage - Mt. Cath.
in b.g. would have made fine
picture but I had left camera
believe - nice tame coney too at
rock below climbing cliff - Rhoda
Pouse & friends on front seats - To
stay at cabin one night. Found
that lost dogwood pin - Had
come up trail from camp site

along stream - 2 big tents there
at old camp site - probably for
construction workers - Leuk con-
firmed this - Tents were closed
& nice pile of firewood there.
Patch up stream on - not good in
July - all dishes cleaned at lunch
& Donna finally produced a
delicious fish - pink flesh - too
big & I couldn't eat it all - after
lunch went back over trail to
look for pin - thought I would
feel better if I looked for it.
Walked around lake to place
near rocks where I had taken
off jacket - then met two of Rhoda
Freud's May white &
who lives in Van - came home
slowly & at foot of steps from
lake up to bungalow saw pins
upside down at side of step. Could
hardly believe it! Rhoda on
porch - all had tea & cookies
(fr. Bauff) & I walked over

to meadow after seeing buses off - Pat + Everett with Fran Gallagher appeared - Told me Aileen had walked out (new trail last year) - They missed bus but second bus took them down - Parker Hat full but Rhoda + May leave place after dinner sat + talked in lounge - Ate $\frac{1}{2}$ Banff banana about 12 pm - hungry (?) + could n't sleep,

Thurs Aug 12. Best day in a long time - weatherwise - ordered lunch salmon + honey - both poor - had $\frac{1}{2}$ banana too - Went to Ace Hat but Rhoda + May had left to walk out so went to Mac Arthur - Took a number of pictures - clouds were lovely - Took 45 minutes to Schaffer L - Took upper trail to meadow - 2 pretty marmots there - wanted picture but it would have taken long time - also food - Little boy there looking for father

up on Schaffer - when he appeared
he told boy he was to guard rock
seas! After he had boy setting
steps up snow bank; went down
to lake, then around to high rock.
Aaron & Hesse there & strong but
I didn't see them - Had lunch
in shelter of rock from wind & at the
little lake - Sun came out & it
was warm - several parties passed
down lower trail - lots of white
heath - Sign to beware of grizzlies
on second tree A Pass sign - Saw
several Welty parts stacked
in woods near pass - Later party
of six passed enroute from Floe Lake
'cypripedium' name of our edible mush-
rooms (according to Luuk here now)
seemed to be three at Schaffer Lake
One was pink underneath & would
peel like ours - quite a few there
On return found Tom Gallagher
& the two little boys on lawn in
front of Lodge - Took 3 pictures

Wiv at plane inside but later
got him in picture too - Tea - Lots
of people for bus - Gallaghers must
have gone to camp ground - On
my return too I met Tim + two
of the girls who had climbed
both peaks of Dilaray - Bath +
rest - Cocktails on balcony with
Lick, Prentises, + others - Were to
have steak for dinner + when
half the people were served, the
fire extinguisher exploded + covered
everything with foam - Rest of
dinner was ruined - + a lot of
us had shrimp because potato
casserole was for dessert - Lots
of excitement + the kitchen a
mess - Also bad to breathe it
Wrote diary while we waited
finishing this on balcony later
To bed about 10 pm - Lick asleep
+ snorter, new arrival reading
Fri. Aug 13 Weather looks better
ordered lunch + decided to go

up cabin & look for goats in meadow across trail by big rock where I saw them two years ago. Left at 10:10 am - Aaron going to Yukon. Col - Maxine & youngest boy playing cards on their porch - Went up big stream no goats or ducks - Took Sappho High Trail all the way - Ate lunch out of windley big rock near big lake below Prospect - Whistling warms this became very tame - Took apple juice ~~for breakfast~~ pictures (probably poor) & then found film was gone! Had hard boiled egg for lunch - an innovation. Saw parties passed - Pleasant to loiter along. Came back same way went over stream to big rock meadow - signs of goats but only one fresh - Lodge at 3¹⁰ Bath & dressed - some rest & then tea - Hope Maruska had no ill effect from $\frac{1}{2}$ ham sand & lots of left over apple juice which he drank from can as I held it. He loved it. Read Acc Gazette in

eve - has picture of Margaret Waisell
& a lot about avalanche rescue
weather deteriorated & lots of rain
in night - Staff forgets to turn off
fan so I went down & turned it
off. Refrig. where ice is makes
noise but I don't hear it upstairs
This time & confirmed fan was off
Couldn't sleep long time all too
tired - Served some chicken for
lunch tomorrow - At supper they
served 1/2 -

Sat Aug 14 hinst down & so is
barometer! Charged film buying
one 2-5 esp from desk $\frac{1}{2} \frac{5}{6} \frac{3}{3}$ - Will
mail today - wrote diary - In all day
except just before lunch I went out to
go around cabins, but avoided wet
streets - Had chicken sandwich for
lunch w. soup & tomatoes from bacon
& tomato sandwich wh I ordered - Rested
as I was tired - The fan was on a lot -
Have finished all my reading waiting
Read Calg. Herald on balcony.

Pearlmans came for cocktails &
we had quite a crowd - Prentises
wives, Dick & rev. gate crashers -
Run out of chairs - Buffer but hard
for me to chew roast beef & get a
good light over chair - I decided to
find Pearlmans till 9 PM. Show
started with a violent spit - Lorna
in a laundry bag, kicking around
& one man on stilts - all fell down
a lot & one girl was the wind
blowing in one door & out the other!
Then a number of older numbers.
To bed & about 11:30 or 12 smell
toast or bread cooking. Heard
noises below so knew some one
was up. Smell came in window
as well as out in hall -

Sun Aug 15 - mist down & chilly

left - after eating lunch no tea
(theirs) at dining room table

Rian doing accounts & both were coming to Banff at 2 PM. They have a car wh belongs to them not the Club! Too much to expect says Denis - we left about 1 PM to go to Elly Rummel - wandered all over Canmore (old town) hunting it - A lot of new buildings - Club Brown nearby & Elly has a very conspicuous white fence with sign pointing to stables(?) Kev Gallagher rides it horses down at #18-15th St. Elly at 838. She was about to eat lunch - Beautiful nasturtiums at door Took pictures - gallaghers house 4th down - is white & has garage(?) back of it - no signs of occupants. Took picture on way who ate some along in their station wagon but Jim & Far. Boyce on way to Banff - They turned back & we plus Elly R went to see them about 2:15 after stopping twice on way to get books at Library T

mail at 90 - she walks a lot
better but one leg of course is stiff

end a sewer is being built, all
kinds of earth & turds there, The

75° back) but can take it off.
She came for slushy & we went to
Phil's Rest. where I got liver,
she pancreas & 1/2 my liver - couldn't
possibly eat their too large helpings
but it's very good - She had blueberry
pie for dessert - I had only sauce!
Put on my pictures at her house.
Lillian Hickok here & came over.

Muriel had full house of guests
& Dorothy good time alone when
Dor. phoned - had had a drink!
I forgot I couldn't drive after dark
so Lillian H. drove my car back.
She has driven many kinds of cars
& found Ney-place etc. turned. Has
had & mortified job looking after
85 yr old man, longtime friend -
She was tied down except when she
walked the dog! I suit used to that!
Pictures of 1975 looked good on Dor's
screen - not too good on mt R. wall.
Showed Dor. those of this year &
1st lot of 1995 after Lillian came in.
Sat Sept 4 Cloudy again but sun
out - cold wind when I crossed street
to B.C. for breakfast - Phoned Rhoda
who will meet me on Tues. about 145
Wrote diary & did jobs, mending
wash, packing & listing - Sun at A+10
then walked down to see unusual
house off Homestead on river road.
Very strong wind so turned

bark, went to Archives - Helen Shadforth at desk, greeted me most cordially as usual - Found Belmore Browne Room the one on first floor & Swiss guides Room below it - new names to me I read in the new newsletter "The Cairn" - Met Jon Whyte & catch leaves in 1/2 hours - Dr. Leult to be released & will return to O'Hara driven to Bauff by nephew & to O'Hara by Laubs - We sent him several Trium & W.S. news Back to room, read a bit, drink after arrest & dinner at B.C. chef's special lamb-chops (too well done) banana pudding fair) To room & slept well.

Sunday Sept 5, cloudy but some sun. Breakfast at B.C. - Decided to go see Storm Mt. Camp (the old Pollard Castle Mt. Camp) Plowed Dorothy & she will go after church. She was after 12³⁰ as she had to put things away afterwards

So I went in + read her Everest
book pub early as 1924 + told
of Mallory's last climb - Then
to Storm Inn - good lunch of bacon
& tomato sand - I skipped onion
soup + blueberry pie - both
good - Ate in enclosed porch - fire

Was raining when I came in & town & cafés crowded even at 8 PM.

Sept 6 Labor Day - after breakfast ran out Vermillion Lakes Rd - 3 ducks far out & quite a few gulls - Cloudy beautiful - Dorit went to BSF with me & lunched at Snark bar - pretty good - Big sundae for dessert & I had cake & goo concoction - Toured gift shop for Scarves \$2.85 + paid for my R but too much - Rain - since deer had - Called on Evelyn Chapman & also Ace office Dorit Matthews there to be asst to Ev. M. Hope

finished packing - A.C. for dinner
(veal) wrote 4 letters - won't have
time when I get home - Bed at 12:
